-BRACKENRIDGE ESTATE HOUSE RULES



A warm welcome to Brackenridge. We want your stay to be a very pleasant experience and sincerely appeal to you to observe the following Rules.

- All residents, visitors and contractors must abide by any Covid -19 legislation and Health and Safety as amended from time to time.
 - Please be security conscious at all times.
- 2 Speed Limit: 30 km per hour.
- 3 Traffic circles: Left around ALL traffic circles. Yield to vehicles on your right.
- 4 Dogs: No dogs are allowed on common property, unless on a lead.
 - Hygiene: Please make sure you have doggie poo bags with you or take from our pickup points.
- 5 Guests: All residents are to take full responsibility for their guests while inside the Estate.
 - Please advise Security of your expected guests in advance, especially Christmas and New Year parties.
- Scramblers and Quad bikes: are NOT allowed in the Estate. Scooters & bikes are permitted, provided the exhaust system is not too loud.
- 7 Boats and trailers are NOT to be parked on Common Property.
- 8 Drones are not permitted to be flown on the Estate.
- 9 Refuse: All domestic refuse to be placed in Black plastic bags in Wheelie Bins. All Recycle refuse to be placed in Municipal yellow plastic bags (available at Security). Collection Times: Monday mornings 08h00
- Domestic workers: are to use the two authorized taxis failing which they are to be collected and dropped off at the Security Office.
- After Dark: We reserve the right to prevent residents/tenants entering the estate on foot after dark (this protects the Estate against unruly elements).
- 12 Fast food deliveries: will NOT be allowed into the Estate (this is a potential serious breach of security).
- Fireworks and slaughtering of animals: The lighting of fireworks and the slaughtering of animals as part of celebrations of cultural or religious events or at any other time are prohibited.
- 14 Loud music: over the Festive Season should be avoided after midnight.
- 15 Generators: may only be run between the hours of 07:00 and 22:00 and only when there is a power outage.
- Note: Fines will be issued to homeowners for consistent breach of rules.
